| 10:15 - 11:15 | <p><b>Leaders' Panel - Fireside Chat</b></p> <p>Against a backdrop of shifting global capital flows, rising debt pressures, and an urgent need to finance industrial transformation at scale, this Leaders' Panel brings together heads of state, development finance institutions, and trade and investment bodies to examine what it will take to build a genuinely African-led response to development, with finance at its core.</p> <p>The conversation will explore how multilateral development banks, regional insurers like ATIDI, and governments can work together as co-architects of a new model, one that mobilises domestic capital, reduces the cost of financing, and directs investment into the sectors that will define Africa's next generation: industry, energy, SMEs, and green infrastructure.</p> <p>Our Leaders will explore the case for strengthening African MDBs under the New African Finance and Development Architecture (NAFAD), the role of innovative instruments - including local currency products, blended finance, insurance wraps and political risk insurance - in unlocking transformative projects, and how institutions like ATIDI and the AfDB can serve as practical enablers of President Ruto's industrial transformation agenda.
